Kleam

Lovely Rowan Cotton Lustre knits up quickly in an easy lace mesh stitch. Keep this kerchief tucked in your bag for those cold spring breezes. Worked up in wool this little layer adds a cozy cushion of warmth.

Finished Size: 57" x 13.5" at center panel

Materials and Equipment:

Yarn: ROWAN COTTON LUSTRE (20z/ 50g, 87 yards/ 80m, 10% linen, 35% Modal, 55% Cotton) 2 skeins Color 376 Parsley.

Needles: US 10.5/6.5 mm needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

Gauge: 12 st and 18 rows = 4" in lace mesh st

Special Abbreviations:

yo: yarn over.

k2tog: knit 2 st together.

kfb: increase by knitting in the front and

back of st.

Stitch Patterns:

Lace Mesh St. Multiple of 2 plus 2. Row 1: K1, *yo, K2tog*, k1.





Pattern Directions

Cast on 32 st.

Row A: K1, *yo, K2tog,* work * * to last st, yo, kfb (34 st).

Repeat Row A until there are 86 st.

Row B: Knit on 6 st, k1, *yo, K2tog,* work * * to last st, yo, kfb (94 st).
Work Row B 9 more times (164 st).

Work Row A until there are 186 st.

The bind off row is essentially worked in pattern. K1, *yo, k2tog, pass yo over the st just worked as k2tog, pass first st over the st just worked as k2tog,* work * * until there is one st remaining, bind off.

Weave in ends. Block to finished dimensions.
